A DISCOUT is a decrease in the original price of an item.

To make a profit, stores charge more than what they pay. The increase from what the store pays to the selling price

is called a MARK UP

Finding a Sale Price

Ex:) The original price of a video game is \$35. What is the sale price?

For an item with an

original price of p, the price after a 25% discount is p - 0.25p, or 0.75p. So, a 25% discount is the same as paying 75% of the

original price.




